DEATH OF MR. S. W. TROWELL, OF NEWPORT



Mr. Sidney Walter Trowell, of 97 Trafalgar Road, Newport, died at St. Mary's Hospital yesterday. He was manager of the Newport branch of Messrs. Timothy White and Taylors, Ltd., for 26 years. He retired last year after nearly 51 years with the firm because of ill-health. A life vice-president and former standard-bearer of the British Legion, he was also a member of the old Contemptibles and the island R.A.M.C. Association. Mr. Trowell leaves a widow and a son.

The funeral service will be held on Thursday at St. Thomas's Church, at 2 p.m.
