The Late Mr. Thomas Turley.--As briefly announced in our last issue the death occurred at his daughter's residence, Emsworth, on Wednesday week, of Mr. Thomas Turley, aged 75, who was formerly a well known and respected figure in the business life of the borough while manager of Pan Mills for Messrs. James Thomas and Company. Mr. Turley held this position from 1916 to 1934, when the firm was merged in that of Messrs. Thomas, Gater, and Bradfield, of which he was a director. The interment took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Saturday, the Rev., E. Nicholas, of Sandown, officiating. The chief mourners were Mr. and Mrs. B. Tipple (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. Leigh Thomas (brother-in-law and sister-in-law), and Mrs. Barton Smith. Among others attending were Miss Rich, Messrs. F. Chiverton, J. Fry, W. G. B. Weeks, and F. Guy (former employees of James Thomas and Company), and Mr. S. V. Croucher (Vectis Shipping Company). The floral tributes included one from the staff of Leigh Thomas and Company.
