ALMOST A CENTENARIAN

The death occurred on Christmas Eve at St. Mary's Hospital, a few months short of his 100th birthday, of Mr. Henry Turner, formerly of Spring-vale, Pan-lane, and for the last three years of Little Pan Farm. Mr. Turner was well known as a market gardener, in which business he spent some 60 years. His wife died 10 years ago and he leaves a family of five. He had been confined to his bed for the last 12 months. Mr. Turner was at one time a regular worshipper at the Pyle-street Primitive Methodist Church. The interment takes place this (Saturday) afternoon at Carisbrooke Cemetery.
