DEATH OF MR. A. Q. TYLER. – Many friends who knew him as an electrical fitter and skilful general mechanic in the employ of his father (Mr. E. W. Tyler, of 95 High-street), will regret to learn of the death at the early age of 47, of Mr. Archibald Quinton Tyler, of Daisy Bank, Clarence-road, which occurred on Tuesday. He underwent a serious operation at the County Hospital about a year ago, and although he had not enjoyed the best of health since, it was hoped that he would make a complete recovery until last week-end, when a complication arose, and the trouble proved fatal. He leaves a widow and one young daughter, with whom sincere sympathy is felt. The funeral took place yesterday (Friday) afternoon at Carisbrooke, following a service at St. John's Church, conducted by the Vicar (the Rev. W. H. Mackinnon). The mourners were the widow, Mr. E. W. Tyler (father), Messrs. R. and W. Tyler (brothers), Mr. G. Hayes and Miss S. Hayes (brother-in-law and sister-in-law), Master Peter Robinson (nephew), Mr. C. Allee, and Mr. G. Harris. His fellow employees at Mr. E. W. Tyler's premises also followed, and the wreaths included tributes from them and from the employees at Quinton's.
