Death of Mr. E. F. Upward. – The death occurred at Whitecroft Hospital on Saturday after a long illness of Mr. Edwin Alfred Upward, aged 73, of South Cottage, Gunville. The third son of the late Mr. and Mrs. W. H. Upward of Carisbrooke Road, he assisted in his father's printing business for many years and was a leader of the former St. Paul's, Barton, fife and drum band. The funeral service took place at the Cemetery Chapel on Wednesday and was conducted by the Rev. A. H. Thompson. The family mourners were Mrs. A. L. Upward (widow), Mr. L. G. Upward (brother), Mrs. F. Scovell (sister, also representing Mrs. F. Scovell, (brother-in-law), Mrs. A. A. Upward (sister-in-law), and Messrs. B. and A. Rose (nephews). Mr. W. H.
