### PARKHURST

**Former Prison Officer.**--The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday of Mr. William Henry (Bill) Way, aged 81, of 2 Lower Cottages, Little Whitcombe, who died at his home on Friday week. Mr. Way spent about 40 years in the prison service at Parkhurst. In 1914 he was recalled as a reservist to the Army Service Corps and went to France with the Old Contemptibles. He was a keen sportsman in his earlier days. The Rev. S. F. Cooper (vicar of St. John's) conducted a service at the cemetery chapel. The mourners were Mr. W. E. Way, Mr. and Mrs. D. H.
