Licensed Victualler's Death.--A well known resident in the town has been removed by the death on Saturday of Mr. Alfred Tom West, licensee of the Crispin Inn, Carisbrooke-road. Mr. West, who was 59 years of age, had held the licence of the inn for 25 years, and had previously held licences in Portsmouth and Gosport. He was a man of fine physique, cheerful disposition and kindly nature, which won him a wide circle of friends by whom he will be greatly missed. His wife died only two months ago and sincere sympathy is felt with their only daughter in the double bereavement she has sustained in so short a time. The funeral was at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Tuesday. The Vicar of Carisbrooke (the Rev. H. Ewbank) officiated. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. C. H. Phillips (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. and Mrs. S. Warner (brother-in-law and sister), Mr. and Mrs. Tuck, Mr. O. Smith (Newchurch), Mesdames F. Matthews and King and Mrs. J. Reynolds.
