The deceased, who had reached the age of 80, had been ill for about a month and was recovering when she had a fatal relapse. Although of a retiring disposition, she was well known and highly esteemed. She was a devoted supporter of the Free Wesleyan Church, with which she had a lifelong association, and was a regular worshipper there as long as her health permitted. She was a woman of noble character, whose unostentatious benevolence will be greatly missed. She was a daughter of the late Mr. Richard Morgan, of Ramsdown Farm. Her remains were laid to rest at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday, beside those of her husband, who died 18 years ago. The Rev. A. W Wayet (rector of Gatcombe) officiated.
