CARISBROOKE

The late Mr. C. F. Whitewood.—The death of Mr. C. F. Whitewood, of Alvington Farm Cottage, Carisbrooke, took place suddenly on Thursday week while following his employment. He was aged 67. Mr. Whitewood had been employed at Alvington Manor Farm for 35 years—eight years by the late Mr. William Marsh, 10 years by Mark Marsh, and 17 years by Mr. A. Moody. He was a member of the Newport Brotherhood and of the Wayfarers, Carisbrooke, for many years. The interment took place on Monday at Carisbrooke Cemetery and the service held at the Wayfarers' Fellowship. The Rev. G. J. Chamberlain officiated. Mr. S.
