Sudden Death. - The death occurred suddenly on Saturday, at 34 Carisbrooke Road, of Mrs. Ann Hobson Williams, aged 56, wife of Mr. R. J. Williams. She was formerly well known at East Cowes for her work for the juvenile concert party run by her daughter (formerly Miss Thora Williams), whose efforts resulted in raising a considerable sum for local charities. Mrs. Williams and her family were bombed out of their East Cowes home in 1942 and came to reside here. Much sympathy is felt with the husband, one son, and two daughters in their sudden bereavement. The funeral took at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday, the Vicar of Carisbrooke (the Rev. D. S. McKenzie) officiating. The Mourners were Mr. R. J. Williams, jun. (son) Mr. L. Moul and Mr. and Mrs. E. J. Harris (sons-in-laws and daughters), Miss S. Barnes (niece), and Mrs. E. Early, Mr. R. J. Williams, sen. (husband), and Mrs. L. Moul (daughter) were unable to attend owing to illness.
