Death of Mr. A. F. Wolfe.—A former esteemed business man in the town passed away on Sunday at 1 South-view, the residence of his younger daughter (Mrs. T. Nobbs), in the person of Mr. Arthur Frederick Wolfe, who for about 15 years was in business as a greengrocer at Nodehill. After giving up the business he was for some year groundsman at Saunders-Roe's sports ground at East Cowes, where he was popular with the members. Falling health caused his retirement from this post about six months ago, since when he had been living with his daughter. Mr. Wolfe, who was 68, will be remembered by many for his generosity and helpfulness to those in need.

The funeral was on Thursday, a service being held at St. John's Church, and the interment at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The chief mourners were Miss Wolfe (daughter), Mr. and Mrs. T. Nobbs (son-in-law and daughter), Mr. G. Wolfe (brother), Mr. A. J. Taylor (brother-in-law), Mr. H. Taylor (nephew), and Mr. and Mrs. G. Randall.

Others in the church were Mrs. A. J. Taylor, Miss L. Cantelo, Mrs. F. Bull, Mr. and Mrs. W. Gwilliam, and Messrs. C. V. Cheverton and G. Attrill (representing the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows). There were over 20 floral tributes, including those from the members of the Saunders-Roe Social and Sports Club, and his fellow workers in the employ of the club. Messrs. H. and F.
