Death of Mr. Donald Abraham. - Keen regret and sincere sympathy with his wife and young daughter were aroused by the death in St. Mary's Hospital on Tuesday of Mr. Donald Edwin Abraham, manager of Messrs. A. W. Abraham and Company, at the age of 43. Mr. Abraham was badly injured by enemy action recently. There were hopes for a time that he would recover, but complications arose which proved fatal. He was the second son of the late M. A. W. Abraham, proprietor of a pork-butcher's business in Nodehill, and when it was formed into a company some years ago he became the manager. He held the high esteem of all who had business dealings with him, while his unflinching courtesy and kindness won him many friends, who greatly deplore his death. In the last war he served in France and was wounded. Like his father he was a devoted worshipper and keen worker in the Castlehold Baptist Church, of which he was a deacon. The funeral service took place there yesterday (Friday) afternoon.
