Death of Mr. Alfred Alabone

Newport has lost one of its most notable residents by the death of Mr. Alfred Alabone, who passed away, after a somewhat prolonged illness on Monday last, at the age of 71. As a dentist the deceased was highly skilled, and he attained more than local eminence in his profession, patients often coming from long distances to place themselves under the treatment of the famous Newport specialist. He held for many years the appointment of dentist to the Royal household at Osborne. The late Mr. Alabone was remarkable in other ways. He possessed great mechanical skill, and amongst other examples thereof, he built himself a splendid organ, on which he was a very able performer. As a citizen and in private life he was universally esteemed, and the intelligence of his death will awaken a feeling of widespread and very sincere regret, while equally widespread and sincere will be the sympathy felt for the bereaved family. The funeral took place yesterday (Friday) afternoon, the mourners including the three sons of the deceased (Messrs. Alfred, Walter, and Frank Alabone), Messrs. W. H. Upward, E. Dabell, B. Upward, C. Dabell, and H. W. Morey, sen., Dr. Groves, J.P., and Mr. Robey F. Eldridge, J.P., C C. The first part of the service was performed at the Newport parish church and the interment took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Vicar of Newport (the Rev. Clement Smith) officiating throughout. The polished elm coffin, which was covered with lovely floral offerings, bore the inscription "Alfred Alabone, died March 6th, 1893, aged 71 years." Mr. J. Bevis carried out the funeral arrangements.
