NEWPORT

THE DEATH – took place on Friday week at her residence, 29 Portland-terrace, at the age of 81, of Miss Catherine Allen, youngest daughter of the late Mr. Richard Allen, of Newport. The deceased, who was the last survivor of her family, was one of the oldest members of the Congregational Church, and also of the P.T.E. in connection with it. She had led a retired life for some years owing to indifferent health. Of a kind and generous disposition she was held in great esteem by a large circle of friends. The funeral took place on Tuesday at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the mourners being the Misses Bessie and Ethel Caws (nieces), Messrs. Cecil Grapes and Allan Brown (nephews), and Mr. Frank King. There were several floral tributes. In the absence through indisposition of the Rev. Sirhowy Jones (pastor of the Congregational Church), the Rev. C. F. Braithwaite officiated. The funeral arrangements were carried out by Mr. J. Bevis.
