Barton, of 31 Hunnyhill, and was 12 years employed by Messrs. Bright and Minns. He joined the Hants Regiment on March 1st and was transferred to the Dorset Regiment. He had been less than two months at the Front when his death occurred. Deceased was a steady and much esteemed young fellow. He was a player in the Newport and District Whist League for the Carisbrooke Working Men's Club.
