Death of Mr. E. W. Black. - The death occurred at his residence, Westminster, 53 Offington-drive, Worthing, on Sunday of Mr. Ernest Walter Black, aged 74, fifth son of the late Mr. and Mrs. F. W. Black, of Westminster House, and brother of Sir Frederick Black, and of Mr. J. H. Black, of Westminster House. Mr. Black was educated at the Grammar School and spent his working life in the service of the Westminster Bank. When he retired some 20 years ago he was manager at Tower Bridge, London. He leaves a widow whom he married 14 years ago. He had frequently spent his holidays in his native town, and in pursuit of his favourite game of billiards had played at the County Club and Literary Society. He had been in failing health for some years and the end came rather suddenly. The funeral took place in Carisbrooke Cemetery yesterday (Friday) afternoon.
