Funeral of Mr. E. Bran. – The funeral took place on Monday of Mr. Edwin Bran, of Frimley, Watergate Road, whose death occurred on Thursday week, in his 75th year. Prior to settling down on the Island Mr. Bran had lived in Winchester and had been an employee of Dicks, Ltd., an electrical and plumbing firm, whom he served for over 50 years. To mark the conclusion of his long service he was presented with a silver replica of an ancient measuring bowl. He took up residence in the borough four years ago. Sympathy is extended to his wife and family. The service at the Parish Church was conducted by the Vicar (Canon W. B. Hogg), and the mourners were Mr. and Mrs. E. J. Bran (son and daughter-in-law), Messrs. L. and R. Bran (brothers), and Mesdames C. M. Garnett, and C. F. Weeks, Dicks, Ltd., were represented by Mr. and Mrs. McVean (also representing Mrs. Dicks), and Messrs. H. E. Rogers, R. Slade, A.W. Faithfull, S. Sumnall, J. Noice, and W. Sedgwick (former fellow employees). The interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
