##### NEWPORT

**SUDDEN DEATH.** – Much sympathy is felt for Mr. George H. Brown, carpenter, of 12 Castle-road, in the painfully sudden death of his wife, which took place on Sunday. Mrs. Brown, who was in her 31<sup>st</sup> year, was the daughter of the late Mr. F.D.G. Delamotte, of the Ordinance Survey Office, Southampton. She had been married about six years and had enjoyed fairly good health. On Sunday the deceased got up to get breakfast, her husband, who was not very well, remaining in bed. After a time Mr. Brown thought it strange that he could not hear his wife moving about and on going downstairs he found her lying unconscious on the kitchen floor. Medical assistance was at once summoned, but the deceased, who had had a paralytic stroke, died about 3 o'clock. Mrs. Brown's father died under very similar circumstances. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday afternoon amid many manifestations of sympathy.
