**MUTINY VETERAN'S DEATH.** – The death took place rather suddenly at Orchard Street, Newport, early on Thursday morning, of William Brown aged 74, formerly Sergt.-Major of the 9<sup>th</sup> Lancers, who served through the Indian Mutiny under Lord Roberts, through whose intervention he obtained an extra pension of 6d. per day. Deceased took part in the siege operations at Delhi, and the assault and capture of the city, and he was also present at the relief of Lucknow.
