Railway Worker's Sudden Death. – The death took place suddenly at the chief engineer's yard, St. John's-road Station, Ryde, on Tuesday of Mr. Arthur John *[sic]* Bull, of 43 Hunnyhill, Newport. Deceased, who was a blacksmith's striker, left home for his work at Ryde in his usual health and made no complaint. After the mid-day meal deceased went to the lavatory, where he was later found in a collapsed condition. He was quickly removed to the open air and medical aid was summoned, but he had passed beyond human aid. Mr. Bull, who had been in the employ of the Southern Railway for 23 years, was 62 years of age.
