NEWPORT.

DEATH OF CAPT. CHEVERTON. – The death took place at Glenburn, Carisbrooke-mall, on Saturday, of Captain Alfred Cheverton, of the Indian Ordnance Department, at the age of 56. He was the son of the late Mr. Henry Cheverton, of Newport and had a successful military career. He enlisted in the Royal Field Artillery in 1873, went to India in 1878, and a few years later transferred to the Indian Ordnance Department, in which he rose to the rank of captain, retiring on pension about four years ago. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday, the Rev. W. J. Sugden officiating. The coffin was covered with the Union Jack, on which rested the deceased's helmet, belt, and sword, but owing to the absence of the majority of the men of the Worcestershire Regiment on furlough full military honours could not be accorded the remains. There were no flowers by request.
