DEATH OF THE DEPUTY-MAYOR'S BROTHER

We regret to announce the death of **Mr. George Chiverton**, son of Mrs. G. Chiverton, of West End-terrace, Carisbrooke-road, and brother of Mr. F. Chiverton, T.C., the Deputy-Mayor, which occurred at Beaumaris, North Wales, on Thursday, at the age of 44. Mr. Chiverton had been employed as a draughtsman in North Wales since soon after the outbreak of the war by Messrs. Saunders-Roe, and he had been in indifferent health for some time, but news which immediately preceded the announcement of his death was that he was recovering and would shortly be coming to spend a holiday in the Island. Sincere sympathy is felt with his wife, his mother, and the members of the family. Mr. Chiverton was for some years a commercial traveller for the Carisbrooke Brick and Tile Company, residing at Richmond, Palmers-road, Wootton. He was a keen amateur photographer, a member of the Wootton Camera Club, and his wife, who is a trained nurse, was a valued member of the Wootton V.A.D. of the Red Cross Society before they moved to North Wales. Mr. Chiverton's body will be brought to Newport for burial.
