Death of Mr. H. W. Cool. – The death occurred, following an attack of influenza, at his home, Landscape View, Gunville Road, Carisbrooke, on Wednesday week, of Mr. Henry William Cool, aged 80. Mr. Cool was a well known tradesman, having been employed locally for more than 60 years as a pork butcher. A member of an old Brockenhurst family, he came to the Island in early childhood, and began his working life with the firm of Denton, formerly of the High Street. He remained there for 20 years, and then went to Mr. J. A. Hayles, of St. James's Square, where he was employed for more than 40 years until his retirement a few years ago, His knowledge and ability won him the appreciation of many customers. Mr. Cool was one of the oldest members of the Earl Yarborough Lodge of Oddfellows. The funeral took place on Saturday at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the service in the chapel being conducted by the Rev. Dr. N. Spoor (Congregational minister). The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. F. W. H. Cool and Mr. L. G. Cool (sons and daughter-in-law), Mesdames R. J. Ayres and I. Bell and Miss V. Cool (daughters), and Messrs. J. A. and R. J. Hayles and W. S. and A. V. Gibbs (representing Messrs. Hayles). The arrangements were made by Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son.
