The Late Mr. H. G. Cooper. – The death occurred suddenly on Thursday week at the Royal I.W. County Hospital of Mr. Hilton Gordon Cooper, aged 58, of 29 Albert Street. Mr. Cooper, who was born at Wootton, was employed as an upholsterer for 42 years by Messrs. Wadham and Sons, Ltd. He leaves a widow, one son, and a daughter, with whom much sympathy is felt. The funeral service, which was conducted by the minister (the Rev. C. Cardy), took place at the Victoria Methodist Church, Pyle Street, on Wednesday, and the interment was at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The family mourners were Mrs. D. E. Cooper (widow), Mr. and Mrs. A. G. Cooper (son and daughter-in-law), Mr. and Mrs. B. D. Rolf (daughter and son-in-law), Mr. C. J. Cooper (father), Messrs.
