DEATH OF MR. W. G. CRAPNELL. – We regret to announce the death, which took place on Sunday, after a long illness, of Mr. Walter Gilbert Crapnell, the highly respected landlord of the Castle Hotel. The late Mr. Crapnell came to Carisbrooke from Portsmouth just over five years ago, chiefly for the benefit of his health, and had held the licence of the Castle ever since. Despite his lingering illness the deceased was of a most cheerful and genial disposition, and his loss to the village is greatly regretted. He was a member of the Carisbrooke Bowling Club. He was aged 36. The deepest sympathy of the whole neighbourhood is with Mrs. Crapnell, who is left with a young family. The funeral took place on Thursday afternoon at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Vicar (Rev. W. J. Stobart) officiating. The mourners were Messrs. Stanley Crapnell (brother), Cameron (brother-in-law), Vincent (Southsea), J. Merritt, F. and G. Nobbs (Ventnor), and W. Saunders, of the Eight Bells Hotel (representing the Carisbrooke Bowling Club).
