**DEATH OF MRS. ERNEST DABELL.**—The death took place at the County Hospital on Monday, following an operation, of Mrs. Dabell, of Medina-avenue, wife of Mr. Ernest Dabell, and a member of an old and much esteemed Newport family. The funeral took place yesterday at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Rev. R. Sirhowy Jones officiating. The mourners included Mr. Alfred Alabone (brother), and Messrs. C. Dabell, J.P., Morris Dabell, Walter Dabell, W. H. Upward, Arthur Alabone, C. J. Minns, and J. W. Marshall, Miss Etheridge, and Mrs. Shilson.
