DEATH OF MR. JOHN DASHWOOD.

We regret to record the death of Mr. John J. Dashwood, which took place at his residence, Havelock Villa, Castle-road, Newport, during Thursday night, in his 78th year. It was only last week that we chronicled the death of his brother, Mr. James Dashwood, J.P., of Ryde. The late Mr. John Dashwood was one of the best known members of the old and respected Island family to which he belonged. He was for many years a member of the old Island Highway Board and of other county bodies, and in all matters connected with the agricultural industry he took the deepest interest, being for many years the occupier of Redway Farm, which was his property. He maintained his marvellous physical activity and vigour almost to the last, and his genial and buoyant personality will be much missed. The sympathy of the whole community is with the bereaved family in their sorrow. The funeral takes place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Monday afternoon next.
