DEATH OF THE MR. C.R.G. DILLON. – We are sorry to announce, this week, the decease of Mr. Charles Richard George Dillon, the son of Hon. Gerald and Lady Louisa Dillon, which took place at his residence, the Terrace, Ryde, on Saturday evening. Some few days since the deceased accidentally injured his hand. The wound grew worse, and mortification becoming evident, his medical attendants recommended amputation as the only means of saving life. Mr. Dillon, however, declined to allow that operation to be performed, and the consequence was that he expired on Saturday, after much suffering. His corpse was removed to St. Marie's (Catholic) Church on Wednesday, where it lay all night. Certain ceremonials were there observed, and on Thursday he was buried in the cemetery at Carisbrooke.
