**DEATH OF MR. WILLIAM DOVE.** — The death occurred on Tuesday morning of Mr. William Dove, aged 73, of Trafalgar-road, who was well known not only in the town and Island, but in the South and West of England markets as a cattle dealer for well over half a century. Deceased was the last of the old school of dealers, and was noted for his sound business judgment. Since he has been laid by he has been much missed in the Newport and other markets. He was held in warm regard by a wide circle of friends. Mr. Dove was a valued member of the Primitive Methodist Church, an ardent Liberal, and an enthusiastic follower of cricket, being a familiar figure among the spectators at local matches.
