Death of Mr. James Dove. - The death occurred on Sunday morning at 54 Trafalgar-road, of one of the oldest and most respected of Newportonians, Mr. James Dove, whose oft expressed wish that he might live till he was 80 was gratified, as he celebrated the 80th anniversary of his birth just three weeks before his death. Deceased enjoyed good health until shortly before the end, when the infirmities attendant upon old age developed rapidly. In his early days he was a butcher in the town, but he will be chiefly remembered as a cattle dealer, which business he carried on with his brother, Mr. William Dove, who survives him, for over 50 years. During that long period he was a most familiar figure in the Newport Market. With wide experience of the Island and mainland markets and West Country fairs, he showed remarkably accurate judgement in the buying of sheep, cattle, &c., and he was much respected in the Island, as well as at the mainland markets which he attended. He was a valued member of the Primitive Methodist Church and one of the oldest members of the St. Thomas's Men's Bible Class, and at Sunday afternoon's meeting of the class Mr. J. H. Poad, the special speaker, made feeling reference to his death and paid a tribute to his devotion to the interests of the class and to his regular attendance whilst health permitted. In politics the late Mr. Dove was an ardent Liberal. The funeral took place on Wednesday at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Rev. S. Ainsworth (Primitive Methodist) officiating. The mourners were Messrs. James, William, Richard, and Frederick Dove (sons), Messrs. William, Richard, and Harry Dove (brothers), Messrs. James, William, and Frederick Dove (grandsons), Messrs. F. Hunt and William Dove, jun. (nephews), Mr. H. Lower (granddaughter's husband), Mr. Love (Sandown), Mr. T. H. Midlane, Mr. Fred Buckler, Mr. H. Burt, Mr. C. J. Dashwood, Mr. S. W. P. Whitcombe, and Mr. R. Bennett, and Messrs. A. Campbell, W. Lee, and M. Hurry (St. Thomas's Bible Class). The funeral arrangements were carried out by Mr. F. Spanner.
