The Late Mr. F. G. Edmunds.—The funeral took place on Friday week at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Rev. L. J. D. Wheatley officiating of Mr. Frederick George Edmunds, of Zealandia, Forest Road, whose death occurred suddenly the previous Monday at the Trinity House pilot department's offices at Marvin's Yard, East Cowes, where he was employed as a storekeeper. The mourners were Messrs. W. J. and E. Edmunds (brothers), Messrs. A. W. Grisley, F. Heathfield, and G. L. Rackett (brothers-in-law), Mr. R. Rackett (nephew), and Messrs. P. Dimmick and B. Stotesbury. Others present included representatives of the Trinity House Pilot Department and the Conservative Club. Mrs. Edmunds (widow) was unable to attend. Among the floral tributes were those from the Corporation, Trinity House, London, the crews of the pilot vessels Gurnard, Brook, and Panda, the Conservative Club, and friends of Forest Road.
