CARISBROOKE.

SUDDEN DEATH.— A well known inhabitant of Carisbrooke passed away very suddenly on Monday morning in the person of Mr. William Elliott. The deceased was going to Newport to business, as usual, and when near the end of the Carisbrooke Mall he was seen to suddenly fall. He was picked up in an unconscious state and taken to a house on the opposite side of the road. Dr. Thompson was soon in attendance but life was found to be extinct. The deceased had been failing in health for some time past and had been attended by Dr. Groves, who was able to certify as to the cause of death, which was attributed to heart disease. The late Mr. Elliott had for the last 16 years been in the employ of Messrs. Whittington and Harvey, grocers, of Newport. He was well known and much respected at Carisbrooke and had for some years past been one of the sidesmen of the Parish-church. Much sympathy is felt for the bereaved widow. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday afternoon. The first portion of the service took place at the Parish-church, the Vicar (the Rev. A. W. Milroy) officiating. A number of parishioners and others were present and deceased's fellow sidesmen (Messrs. Marshall, Brown, and King) also attended. Mr. A. Whittington and Mr. Harvey (deceased's employers) and some employees were amongst those present. The Rev. J. W. M. Williams officiated at the grave side.
