Young Home Guardsman's Death. – The death took place on Monday at his home, 1b Pyle-street of Mr. Edwin Albert Evans, aged 23, second son of Mr. and Mrs. W. Evans, a popular worker at Messrs. J. S. White and Company's works, Somerton, and a member of the local company of the Home Guard. Much sympathy is felt with his parents and the other members of the family in their bereavement. The funeral was on Thursday in Carisbrooke Cemetery, the Rev. H. Ewbank, R.D. officiating. The chief mourners were his parents, Mr. and Mrs. W. J.
