#### SUDDEN DEATH AT NEWPORT.

Yesterday (Friday) afternoon the Deputy Coroner (Francis A. Joyce, Esq.) held an inquest at the Sir John Barleycorn Inn, Newport, on the body of William Edwin Evans, of 44 Elm-grove, Newport, whose dead body was found early that morning lying under his donkey cart in the road near deceased's house. Mr. M. J. Plucknett, dairyman, gave evidence as to finding deceased, who witness thought fell under the donkey when he was holding the animal, and Dr. Barr having expressed the opinion that death was due to heart disease, there being no marks of violence, the jury, of which Mr. Knott was foreman, returned a verdict of "Death from natural causes."
