The Late Mrs. K. Flux. – The death occurred on Thursday week of Mrs. Kate Flux, aged 78, of 13 Trafalgar Road. Mrs. Flux was born at Shorwell and later moved to Gatcombe, where she was a member of the choir. Before she married, 58 years ago, and came to live at Newport, she had been teacher at Chillerton School. A prominent member of the Congregational Church, with her husband, she had been the caretaker of the church for eight years until Mr. Flux became the caretaker of the secondary school. The funeral took place on Monday, a service at St. James's Congregational Church being conducted by the Minister (the Rev. Dr. N. Spoor). In his address the minister referred to the good work that Mrs. Flux had done for the church... The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. L. Flux (son and daughter-in-law), Mrs. Buckley (daughter), Mrs. Jackson (niece, also representing her mother), the Misses E. and L. Ryall (nieces, also representing their mother), and Mr. A. Chiverton (cousin). Mr. W. Flux (widower) and Mr. and Mrs. P.W. Flux (son and daughter-in-law) were unable to attend. The interment followed at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The floral tributes included one from the neighbours and friends of Trafalgar Road. Messrs. O.C. Hamilton and Son made the arrangements.
