DEATH OF MRS. GEORGE GROVES. – The death took place at Springvale on Monday of Mrs. Groves, widow of Mr. George Groves, aged 75. Deceased, who had lived in Chillerton throughout her married life, had been a teacher in the United Methodist Sunday-school for 40 years, and was regarded with great affection by all the children, whilst her kind-hearted neighbourliness endeared her to all in the village. There was a large attendance at the funeral at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday, when the Rev. T. Letcher officiated.
