Her husband pre-deceased her 26 years ago. There was a family of eight children, seven of whom are living. Three sons are farming in New Zealand. Much sympathy is felt with the relatives in their bereavement. Her mortal remains were laid to rest beside those of her husband at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Tuesday.
