SALVATION ARMY FUNERAL. – On Sunday morning last an old and respected member of the local corps of the Salvation Army passed away in the person of Mr. Eneas Holbrooke [sic], aged 54, of Barton-road. He had been connected with the corps some 16 years, and had been a "sergeant" for the greater part of the time. The funeral took place on Wednesday afternoon at Carisbrooke Cemetery, the impressive service being conducted by Ensign Clayson and Captain Whitehouse, the latter officer, who was formerly connected with the local corps, coming specially to take part. The funeral precession was led by the band, playing funeral marches, and hymns were sung at the graveside.
