Death of Mr. F. G. Horan. – Last week it was regretfully our duty to record the passing of Mr. H. W. Horan, a respected and prominent citizen; we have in this issue to announce the death at Caerbrook, Castle-road, on Tuesday, of his brother, Mr. Frederick George Horan, aged 81. The deceased, though not so well known locally as his late brother, had spent much time at Caerbrook since his retirement from business life soon after the last war. A former manager and inspector in the service of the Westminster Bank, he had managed many important branches, chiefly in the area surrounding London. He was a bachelor and was of a quiet and retiring disposition, but he had nevertheless become well known to many residents in the Newport district, who deeply regret his death. He was the inseparable companion of his brother, whom he greatly resembled, and renewed sympathy is extended to the members of the family in their double bereavement.
