The Late Mr. E.J.W. Jacobs. – The death occurred suddenly on Saturday of Mr. Edward James William Jacobs, of 16 Field Place, aged 55. He collapsed on the Mall and was taken into Dr. J. Dowdall's residence, but was found to be dead. The facts were reported to the Coroner, who decided that an inquest was not needed. Mr. Jacobs had been a miller in the employ of Messrs. Leigh Thomas and Co. since the age of 13½. During the first world war he served in the Army. Mr. Jacobs leaves two daughters. His wife died 12 years ago. The service was at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday, the Rev. S.F. Cooper officiating. The mourners were Mr. and Mrs. C. Cooke and Mrs. E. Clevett (son-in-law and daughters), Mr. B. Jacobs (uncle), Mr. and Mrs. L. Ralph, and Messrs. L. Weeks and B. Payne, representing Messrs. Leigh Thomas and Co. The arrangements were made by Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son.
