DEATH OF MR. W. JEFFERY. – The regret we feel in announcing the death of Mr. William Jeffery will, we are sure, be shared by all who knew that highly-respected and esteemed inhabitant of Newport. His illness, which was not a long one, originated in a chill, and though serious symptoms supervened, a strong hope was cherished that his life would be spared. That hope, unhappily, has not been realised. Mr. Jeffery passed away on Wednesday last. The deceased had been for 35 years in the office of which Mr. Harbottle Estcourt is now the head, and it is a matter of common knowledge that, by his unswerving integrity, he won the complete confidence and the warmest regard of those whom he served so long and so faithfully. The late Mr. Jeffery was one of the elective auditors of the borough, and he also held the office of secretary of the Newport Gas Company. In those positions he exhibited the same rectitude and conscientiousness that marked his performance of other duties, and he will be remembered as one who steered a straight course and lived a worthy life.
