Death of Mr. B. Jolliffe – The death took place on Thursday week of Mr. Bernard Jolliffe, aged 62, of 45 Elm-grove. He had been ill for about six months and had undergone an operation at the I.W. County Hospital. The deceased was employed at Whitecroft Mental Hospital for some 32 years as mason and was held in high esteem by his workmates and neighbours. The funeral took place on Tuesday in Carisbrooke Cemetery, Major Straw, of the Salvation Army officiating. The mourners were the widow, Leslie and Cecil (sons), Mrs. L. Jolliffe (daughter-in-law), Messrs. Albert, George, and Gilbert Jolliffe (brothers), Mrs. Gilbert Jolliffe (sister-in-law), Mr. J. Differy, and Mr. F. Draper (brothers-in-law), and Gunner A. Jolliffe (nephew). Several of his workmates at the Mental Hospital also attended. There were a number of beautiful wreaths, including those from the officers and staff; outdoor staff of the Mental Hospital; members of the Mental Union; and the neighbours of Elm-grove. Mr. O. C.
