**SUDDEN DEATH.** – The Deputy Coroner (Francis A. Joyce, Esq.) held an inquiry on Saturday on the body of Sarah Jones, 65, of Roslin Cottage, who was found dead in bed on the previous Wednesday. Ernest Jones, deceased's son, said his mother appeared in her usual health on the previous night, and retired about 9 p.m. At 2.30 a.m. he heard her snoring, but at 6 a.m., on going to call her, he found that she had passed away in her sleep. Dr. E.F.W. Buckell, who was called in immediately, said deceased had every appearance of having died from heart disease. When attending her husband in September witness prescribed for her shortness of breath, but he had never examined her. Dr. Hutton Castle, who had previously attended deceased, said she was suffering from valvular heart disease, and a verdict that death was due to this cause was returned.
