Ex-Airman's Death – The death took place at St. Mary's Hospital on Monday of Mr. Harold Lee, of 14 Albert-street. He was 37 and had served as an aircraftman with the R.A.F. for 12 months, but was discharged on account of his health. Before joining up he was employed by the highways department of the County Council. He leaves a widow and two young children. The funeral was on Wednesday in St. John's Church, the Rev. W. H. Mackinnon officiating, and the interment followed at Carisbrooke Cemetery. The family mourners were Mrs. H. Lee (widow), Mr. E. Lee (brother), Mesdames J. Jones and L. Williams (sisters), G. and W. Mackett (brothers-in-law), and Mrs. E. Lee and Mrs. L. Kirby (sisters-in-law). Others present included Mr. and Mrs. T. Cave, Mr. P. Newberry, Mrs. Reynolds, and Mr. W. Pragnell.
