DEATH OF THE OLDEST ISLAND FARMER. – We regret to announce the death, at the residence of his son-in-law (Mr. J. P. Harvey), at Chale Abbey Farm, on Wednesday, of Mr. James Lock, at the great age of 90. He is believed to have been the oldest farmer in the Island. For six years he was at Forest Farm, 18 at Alvington, and for the rest of his time at Great Park. He represented the parish of St. Nicholas on the Island Board of Guardians, but retired in favour of the late Mr. Arthur Sotheran Estcourt, L.L.B. He also served as an overseer. The funeral will take place at Carisbrooke Cemetery today (Saturday) at 2.30 p.m.
