CARISBROOKE.

DEATH OF MR. JAMES LOCK. – The death occurred on Monday, at Stile House, where he had been living in retirement for about seven years, of a member of an old and much esteemed Island agricultural family, in the person of Mr. James Lock, formerly of Combley Farm. Deceased, who was in his 78th year, farmed Combley in succession to his father, Mr. William Lock. He enjoyed good health until about a fortnight ago, when an internal disorder asserted itself and proved fatal. He leaves a widow and family of two daughters and four sons. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Wednesday in the presence of relatives, a few friends, and members of the Community of Brethren, with which he had worshipped for many years. All the members of his family were present, with the exception of one son, who is in Canada.
