#### DEATH OF MR. J. E. LOCK, OF CARISBROOKE.

We regret to record the death, which took place last (Friday) evening, of Mr. James Edward Lock, of Priory Farm, Carisbrooke, at the age of 43. Dr. Underhill, of Newport, who was called in on Saturday night last, found the deceased gentleman suffering from appendicitis. Dr. Buck attended on the following day for consultation, and as the patient afterwards got somewhat better it was hoped to avoid an operation. However, the symptoms on Wednesday morning necessitated the operation, which was entirely successful, the result showing that it was the only chance of recovery. Unfortunately attacks of heart failure supervened, and it was to one of these sudden attacks that he succumbed. The deceased gentleman, who was a much esteemed agriculturist and a valued parochial worker at Carisbrooke, was elected one of the churchwardens of that parish at the last Easter Vestry. He was a good friend of the Cottage Garden Show, of which he was in its early days a very devoted and efficient hon. sec., and he had again place his field at the disposal of the committee for this year's show. He had also been a member of the Carisbrooke Church choir. He was one of the smartest of the Island Troop of Hampshire Yeomanry in its early days, being a very efficient and popular non-com. officer. The deepest sympathy is felt with the widow and her young family in their heavy bereavement. The funeral will take place on Monday afternoon next, leaving the Priory at 2 o'clock.
