CARISBROOKE.

FATAL ACCIDENT AT CARISBROOKE. – An inquest was held on Monday last at the Carisbrooke Castle Inn, Carisbrooke, before F. Blake, Esq., coroner, on the body of Elizabeth Ann Lockhart, a child two years and ten months of age, who was rode over and was instantly killed on the previous Saturday afternoon, by a carriage belonging to Mr. Wm. George of Glenfield villa, near the Village of Carisbrooke. After hearing the evidence of the eye witnesses of the occurrence, the jury, without hesitation, returned a verdict of “Accidental Death.”
