

## Harriet Ann Martin

### NEWPORT

**A Nonagenarian.** - The death occurred on Saturday of Mrs. Harriet Ann Martin, of Ellerslie, Mount Pleasant Road, aged 94. Mrs. Martin was the widow of Mr. Charles Martin, the former county horticultural instructor, who died in 1946. Mrs. Martin, a native of Dorset, came to the Island in 1888, the year of her marriage. Her only son died in the first world war and she leaves a daughter. The funeral service took place on Wednesday at the Congregational Church. The Rev. A. J. Perry officiated and Miss K. Lower, at the organ, accompanied the hymns "Hark, hark, my soul" and "The King of love". The family mourners were Miss E. Martin (daughter), Mr. and Mrs. A. and Mr. W. Martin (nephews and niece), Miss M. Sanders and Miss A. Warne. The floral tributes included one from the V.A.D. detachment of the Red Cross, which was represented at the service. Interment followed in Carisbrooke Cemetery. The arrangements were made by Messrs. O. C. Hamilton and Son.
