DEATH OF AN EX-POSTMAN. – Mr. George Meech, a well-known local postman, passed away on Saturday last at the age of 48. The deceased was for over 20 years engaged in the postal service at Newport, from which he retired on a pension some six or seven years ago. He was an old member of the Carisbrooke Bowling Club and he belonged to Court Island Foresters. The funeral took place at Carisbrooke Cemetery on Thursday afternoon, the Rev. A. E.
